### 3-3-5

Homeworks and exams were incredibly difficult so much so that every office hour completely filled the office, as this was the only way to complete HW. With a curve so low on exams (18/42) on first midterm) and so many people seeking help, this should say something about the difficulty of the course.

### 9-9-8

It would be nice to use the book a little more often. I used it primarily as a reference, which isn't bad, but having paid so much for it, I expected to use it more. The homework problems were rather difficult. On the weekends, I could not effectively seek assistance perhaps a selection of easier/ more fundamental problems would help.

On a scale of 1-10, w/ 10 being hardest, hw was on a level of 8-10 & I spent at least 8 hours on hw every problem set. If youre introducing new concepts it would help to start out with easy problems and work up to the complex ones, even if it means giving more problems. Having a lesson in class about the basics and then jumping to extremely hard problems on hw didn't help me a lot. But I can tell you put a lot of effort in so thank you.

### 7-6-6

The teaching is excellent for this course; however, the grading seems too harsh as I find it difficult at best to complete the homework in the given 8 hours per week. This course is a little too rigorous considering it is a very low division. More mediocre rather than difficult problems would be appreciated in order to understand the subject matter rather than purely worry about the grade.
