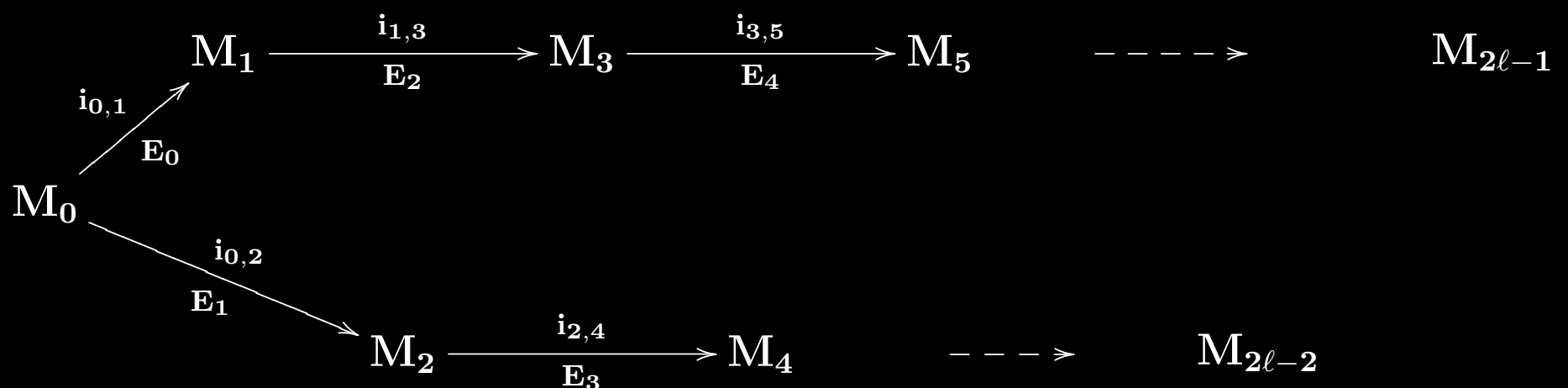


Steel VIG
