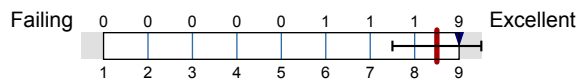

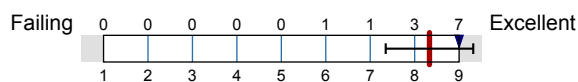

1.1) How would you rate your instructor as an effective teacher?



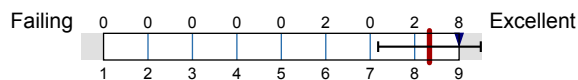

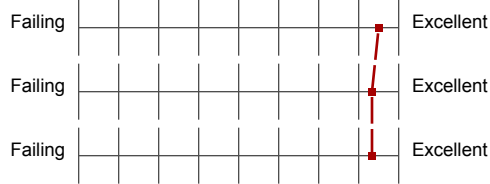
