

### MATH 31B QUIZ 1A.

(1) What is the correct definition of a 1-1 function?

- (a) For each  $y$ , there is at most one  $x$  with  $y = f(x)$
- (b) For each  $x$ , there is at most one  $y$  with  $y = f(x)$
- (c) For each  $x$ ,  $f(x)$  has a unique value.
- (d)  $f(x) = x^3$ .
- (e) None of the above

The answer is (a)

(2) Let  $f(x) = \ln(x^3 \sin x)$ . Then  $f'(x)$  is equal to:

- (a)  $\frac{1}{x^2 \sin x}$
- (b)  $\frac{3}{x} + \cot x$
- (c)  $\frac{x^2 \sin x}{x^3 + \sin x}$
- (d)  $\frac{x}{2x^2 - \cos x}$
- (e) None of the above

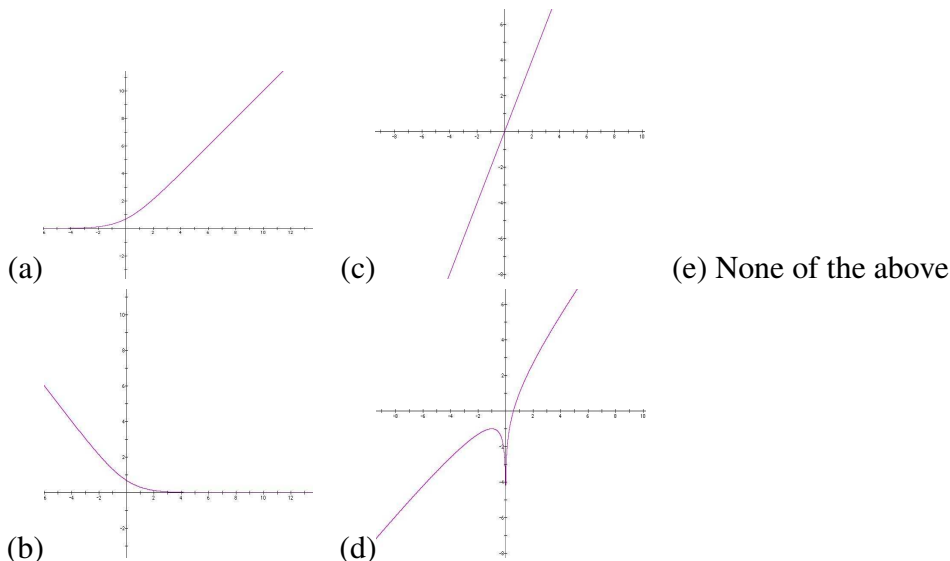
The answer is (b):  $\ln(x^3 \sin x) = 3 \ln x + \ln \sin x$ ; differentiating gives (b).

(3) Let  $L = \lim_{t \rightarrow \infty} e^{-1/t}$ . Then

- (a)  $L = 1$
- (b)  $L = \infty$
- (c)  $L = 0$
- (d)  $L = -1$
- (e) None of the above

The answer is (a):  $-1/t \rightarrow 0$  and  $e^0 = 1$ .

(4) Let  $f(x) = \ln(e^x \cdot e^x)$ . Which is the graph of  $f$ ?



The answer is (c):  $\ln(e^x e^x) = \ln(e^{2x}) = 2x$ .
