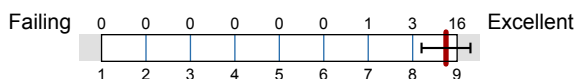

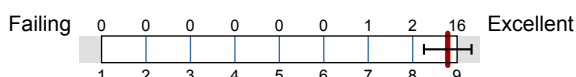

1.1) How would you rate your TA as an effective teacher?



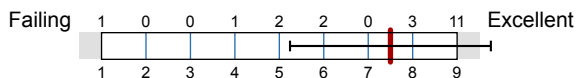

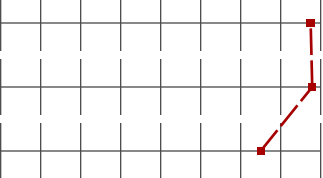
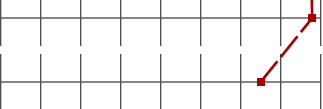

- I just wanted to note that I'm graduating this quarter, and Cecelia is one of the best TAs that I have had. She explains things very well, and is very organized with her work.
